REDERAL MILITARY GOVERNMENT ISUPREMACY AND ENFORCEMENT OF POWERS) DECREE 1994



Decree No. 12

(18th November, 1993) Commencement

WHEREAS the military revolution which took place on 17th November, 1993 effectively abrogated the whole pre-existing legal order in Nigerial except what has been preserved under the Constitution (Suspension) and Modification) Decree No. 107 of 1993.

AND WHEREAS the military revolution aforesaid involved an abrupt political change which was not within the contemplation of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1979

AND WHEREAS BY THE Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree No. 407 aforesaid there was established a new government known as the "Federal Military Government" with absolute powers to make laws for the peace, order and good government of Nigeria or any part thereof with respect to any matter whatsoever and, in exercise of the said powers, the said Federal Milhary Government permitted certain provisions of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1979 to remain in operation.

AND WHEREAS by section 5 of the said Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree, no question as to the validity of any Decree or any Edict (in so far as by section thereof the provisions of the Edict are not inconsistent with the provisions of a Decree) shall be entertained by any Court of law in Nigeria.

AND WHEREAS by section 1(3) of the said Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree the provisions of a Decree shall prevail over those of the unsuspended provisions of the said 1979. Constitution 1980

(4(1) the preamble hereso is hereby affirmed and declared as forming parts premison of of this Decrée.

 - (a) for the efficacy and stability of the Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria; and
 - (b) with a view to assuring the effective maintenance of the cernitorial integrity of Nigeria and the peace, order and good government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 🛂 🎠
